2018 FCA-CC Kart Racing Series



Do you have an interest in Kart racing? The club is looking to gauge interest in organizing a Kart racing series this spring and early summer.

We need to gauge interest before we can financially commit to these events. Please review the preliminary details outlined below: (Big thanks to club member, Peter Fatianow, for organizing this)

This is a three-event race series at three different Denver area kart tracks, two indoor with electric karts and one outdoor with gas karts.

RULES

To qualify for the top three prizes you have to participate in at least two of the three events. The official club timekeeper will record times of each driver at each event. We will use the F1 points system to award points at the end of each event. Each driver will participate in two timed races per event. Each race will have no more than 10 drivers on the track at the same time, so there will be three driving groups: A, B, and C. Drivers will be competing against all the drivers in each of the three groups based on total time for each of the two races per event.
